

# USAGE GUIDELINES

## SOCIAL DISTANCING

Government guidelines surrounding social distancing must be adhered to at all times.

## BRING YOUR OWN EQUIPMENT

Water is available for those who need it, however we would encourage those who can to bring their own water, muck clearing tools etc.

## GLOVES TO BE USED TO HANDLE SHOW JUMPS

To reduce the risk of contamination, we are asking those hiring the show jumping arena to supply their own disposable gloves to handle the equipment.

## NO TOILETS

The toilet facilities at Attington will be closed in a bid to reduce areas of contact/contamination

## EXERCISE NOT SOCIALISE

We are not opening for social purposes. Those attending are only permitted to bring one additional member of their household with them

## THOSE WITH SYMPTOMS

If you or a member of your household have symptoms or have had symptoms in the past 7 days please do not attend.

# USAGE GUIDELINES

## PARKING

Please ensure there is sufficient space between lorries.

## DUTY OF CARE

External coaches have a duty of care over their riders. We require them to provide a copy of their insurance in advance and require them to be onsite for their rider's arrival and departure.

## ARENA NUMBERS

In accordance with current Government guidelines only 1 horse and 1 person on foot will be allowed in the arenas at any one time. The exception for this being 2 members of any one household or 2 members from different households. Social distancing rule must be observed at all times.

## 1 HOUR WINDOW

## CLEAN HANDS
