

# USAGE GUIDELINES – JUNE



## ARENA NUMBERS

In accordance with current Government guidelines we are limiting the numbers in the cross-country arena. The revised usage numbers are as follows:

- There will be a maximum of 2 individual bookings per hour. This could accommodate up to 4 horses.
- Only 1 teaching clinic per hour will be booked into the cross-country arena. This may be up to 4 horses/riders.
- Those bringing coaches with them or coaches attending for 1-2-1 or 2-2-1 coaching sessions need to be aware of all social distancing requirements and ensure that we have no more than 6 people in the arena at any one time.
- Horses/Riders based at Attingham may be in the arena at any time.
- Spectators should be kept to a minimum and stay outside the arena where possible.

## NO DOGS

No dogs are allowed in any arenas. Dogs should be kept on leads at all times and must be cleared up after.

# USAGE GUIDELINES

## SOCIAL DISTANCING

Government guidelines surrounding social distancing must be adhered to at all times.

## BRING YOUR OWN EQUIPMENT

Water is available for those who need it, however we would encourage those who can to bring their own water, muck clearing tools etc.

## GLOVES TO BE USED TO HANDLE SHOW JUMPS

To reduce the risk of contamination, we are asking those hiring the show jumping arena to supply they own disposable gloves to handle the equipment.

## NO TOILETS

The toilet facilities at Attington will be closed in a bid to reduce areas of contact/contamination

## EXERCISE NOT SOCIALISE

We are not opening for social purposes. Those attending are only permitted to bring one additional member of their household with them

## THOSE WITH SYMPTOMS

If you or a member of your household have symptoms or have had symptoms in the past 7 days please do not attend.

# USAGE GUIDELINES

## PARKING

Please ensure there is sufficient space between lorries.

## 1 HOUR WINDOW

Due to the new social distancing rules the 1 hour booking window must be observed. If you are wishing to bring multiple horses to ride within the 1 hour window please email [sarah@equiconsulting.co.uk](mailto:sarah@equiconsulting.co.uk)

## CLEAN HANDS

Sanitiser stations are being made available for visitors to use. We would encourage visitors to wash their hands at regular intervals

## NO YARD ACCESS

At this time we request that no one enters the stable yard or office area.
